REGULATION NO. 8

SUBJECT: Cooperative's Right to Disconnect Service

REGULATION:

I. Without Notice

The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue the supply of electric service to any member or member without notice, including without limitation, for any of the following reasons:

- A. Fraudulent representation as to the use of electric service;
- B. Any disapproval of the member's equipment or installation because of defects or hazardous conditions;
- C. Repairs or emergency operations;
- D. Unavoidable shortage or interruptions in the Cooperative's source of supply;
- E. Whenever such action is necessary to protect the Cooperative from fraud or abuse; and
- F. Upon cancellation of contract for service.

II. With Reasonable Notice

The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue service upon reasonable notice:

- A. For nonpayment of an electric service bill.
- B. If entry to its meter or meters is refused or if access thereto is obstructed or hazardous.
- C. If these regulations, policies or bylaws of the Cooperative are violated.

III. Disconnect/Reconnect Fee

As a condition precedent to the restoration of service, a charge shall be made for each trip to a member's premises to disconnect or to reconnect service as specified in Regulation No. 21 – Rates and Fees. Any disconnect/reconnect made on overtime will be billed at a higher rate as specified in Regulation No. 21 – Rates and Fees.
