STREET LIGHTING SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE SL-1

Availability

This rate schedule is available to towns, villages, rural communities, and subdivisions for dusk-to-dawn street lighting.

Rate per Light per Month

100 Watt Sodium Vapor	\$ 6.95
175 Watt Mercury Vapor	\$ 7.50
400 Watt Mercury Vapor	\$13.75

Service Provisions

- 1. Street lighting systems must have a minimum of six streetlights with an average distance of not more than 600 feet between lights in order to be eligible for service under this rate schedule.
- 2. Street lighting equipment, including poles, lamps, fixtures, time switches, photoelectric controls, circuits, transformers, guys and fittings will be furnished by the Cooperative and shall remain the property of the Cooperative.
- 3. The Cooperative reserves the right to refuse the installation of a streetlight if the cost of such installation is determined to be excessive in relation to the annual charge, unless the member agrees to pay the excess installation cost.
- 4. The Cooperative will install additional streetlights in accordance with the previously mentioned charges and conditions upon written request by the member.
- 5. Replacements of lamps or other components due to normal depreciation, consumption, or burnout will be made without extra charge to the member. Replacements of lamps or other components due to vandalism or willful destruction will be made without extra charge to the member, provided the number of such replacements during the calendar year will not exceed 20 percent of the number of streetlights in the system. Should the number of replacements during a calendar year exceed 20 percent of the number of streetlights in the system, the member shall be required to pay for the excess lamps or other components replaced based on the Cooperative's current cost of the lamps or other components.
- 6. Street lighting service shall be available under this rate schedule only if a single person, firm, corporation, association, or governmental body will assume responsibility for payment of bills for such service. A written agreement between the member and the Cooperative shall be required before street lighting service will be furnished under this rate schedule.

7. Mercury vapor lighting is no longer available for new installations. When mercury vapor equipment is no longer available to repair current equipment, the Cooperative will replace the fixture with a suitable alternative, which a member may decline.

Utility Taxes

Any tax or fees levied on the Cooperative under the Illinois Public Utilities Revenue Act shall be added to the rates and minimum charges specified in this schedule. Any additional taxes that may be imposed by taxing authorities on the member shall also be added to the above rates and minimum charges.

Terms of Payment

The above charges are net, the gross charges being five percent higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the due date printed on the bill, the five percent discount will not apply.
