REGULATION NO. 2

SUBJECT: Classification by Revenue Class

REGULATION:

Each electric service shall be classified for the purpose of determining the applicable revenue class in accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) regulations.

1. Combination Residential and Commercial Service

When electricity supplied through a single meter is used for both residential and commercial purposes, the account shall be classified as either residential revenue class or commercial revenue class, depending upon which class has the greater kWh use.

2. Required Transformer Capacity

With respect to the above classification, the term "required transformer capacity", used in connection with determining the minimum bill under a rate schedule or in distinguishing between the type of the Commercial and Industrial Service shall be taken to mean the capacity which is required to carry the member/owner's electric load rather than the capacity installed. The Cooperative may find it convenient or advisable to install larger transformers than actually required. Where two or more member/owners are served from the same transformer, the minimum charge for each shall be based on the transformer capacity which would normally be installed for each member/owner's individual requirements.
