REGULATION NO. 6

SUBJECT: Access to Premises

REGULATION:

The member/owner shall furnish the Cooperative a suitable site for installation of equipment and facilities, as determined by the Cooperative, whereupon authorized employees, agents, and independent contractors shall have safe and undeterred access thereto for inspection, maintenance, replacement, relocation, or repair thereof at all reasonable times. As part of the consideration for such service, each member/owner shall be the Cooperative's bailee of such facilities and shall accordingly desist from interfering with, impairing the operation of, blocking access to, or causing damage to such facilities, and shall use best efforts to prevent others from doing so. In the event such facilities are interfered with, made inaccessible, impaired in their operation or damaged by the member/owner, or by any other person when the member/owner's reasonable care and surveillance could have prevented such, the member/owner shall indemnify the Cooperative and any other person against death, injury, loss or damage resulting therefrom, including but not limited to the Cooperative's cost of repairing, replacing, or relocating any such facilities and its loss, if any, of revenues, resulting from the failure or defective functioning of its metering equipment. In no event shall the responsibility of the Cooperative extend beyond the point at which its service wires are attached to the meter loop provided by measuring electricity used on such premises.
