REGULATION NO. 9

SUBJECT: Foreign Electricity

REGULATION:

No source of supply of electricity other than the Cooperative's shall be introduced or used by the member/owner in conjunction with service other than a Cooperative approved eligible renewable electrical generating facility in accordance with Regulation No. 26, Net Metering and Cooperative Purchase of Excess Member Owned Generation Capacity and Regulation No. 27, Interconnection and Parallel Operation of Distribution Generation.

Generating plants may be used by the member/owner for stand-by power in the event of interruption of service, provided that:

- a. The Cooperative is notified of the installation; and
- b. A double pole-double throw switch, properly installed, is made a permanent part of the installation.
